As a Sessional Volunteer and Volunteer Driver for those who don't have access to transport, I soon felt part of the group and I enjoyed the weekly meetings. Just making the tea, remembering how each person likes it can make them feel that little bit special. Listening to their stories and achievements is so interesting. Loneliness is a debilitating thing but when you take time to make friends with an older person that friendship is really appreciated. It's rewarding to know they're looking forward to seeing you again next week.

I feel that my background has given me the ability to see people differently, beyond their circumstances, but utilizing the life experience that many of us go through helps me to empathise with the Aspire members and volunteer more effectively.
